SEMESTER 2 Beginner	<u>Beginner</u> The classes in the “beginner” semester set the basic foundation for all following classes. This enables you to first gain a fundamental understanding of the American legal system.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Introduction to US Law and Terminology
SEMESTER 3 Advanced I: Fundamental Knowledge	<u>Advanced I: Fundamental Knowledge</u> These classes pick up where the curriculum of the “beginner” semester left off.
